



West Houston campus

Wood's head office complex is located on the west side of Houston, Texas, near the intersection of Interstate 10 and State Highway 6. This area is known as the "Energy Corridor" of Houston, because of the many major and independent oil companies located within a few miles of this office. There is easy freeway access to both Houston airports, as well as all major business centers in the area.

Senior engineers and staff are typically located in hard-walled offices, adjacent to an administrative assistant station, conference room and a coffee bar, equipped with microwave and refrigerator. Design groups are typically located in cubicles to enhance efficiency and communication, and organized by discipline or task force, depending on the needs of the project. The entire facility is equipped with an access card security system to provide confidentiality for projects and general security.

All engineering, management and design workstations include a computer or CAD system. A computer network with email and selected access to standards, project controls and reference data serves the entire company, including customer offices. CAD stations are linked

to a separate network to provide simultaneous access to design documents and instantaneous plotting capability.

For normal project needs and incidental requirements, standard and color copy machines are located throughout the buildings. All machines have electronic recorders to ensure accurate accounting of reproduction charges.

Layout:

Wood currently leases approximately 500,000 square feet of office space in west Houston. Building layouts are flexible, to allow a matrix organization for smaller projects and task force areas for larger projects. All support services are provided from this Houston location.
